

KINETIC Conflict Minerals Policy

KINETIC TECHNOLOGIES is committed to social and environmental responsibilities in our business activities as well as within our supply chain. In addition to our commitment, we shall meet regulatory obligations in the locations that we operate and specific conflict-free requirements from our valued customers.

The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) adopted rules to implement reporting and disclosure requirements related to conflict minerals, as directed by the **Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010.** The rules require manufacturers who file certain reports with the SEC to disclose whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, Gold(3TG) sourced from mines in conflict areas or high risk regions, or illegally taxed on trade routes, either of which are controlled by non-governmental military groups, or unlawful military factions.

KINETIC TECHNOLOGIES requires our suppliers to comply with the Responsible Business Alliance(RBA) Code of Conduct and only source materials from environmentally and socially responsible suppliers and requires that all suppliers purchase and use minerals that comply with Conflict-Free, and source from the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process(RMAP) Conformant Smelters and Refiners list of the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI)

KINETIC TECHNOLOGIES uses RMI's Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (RMI_CMRT) for our suppliers and internal due diligence activities and reporting to our customers.

In the event when we discover that the use of any of these Conflict Minerals originate from sources that are not deemed conflict-free, we will take the appropriate corrective actions to transition toward a conflict free status.
